Relying on Allah
and Disability

Think of tawakkul as a hot air balloon, rising higher and higher in the sky. There are no boundaries for tawakkul, it will take you to Jannah.

Tawakkul is the worship of the heart. When you depend on Allah, and trust him, you are at peace and

and your heart is at rest, because you know you are relying on the Perfect One, and you know He is sufficient for you. Allah gives you the best choices, when you rely on Him, and take the means at your disposal.

صلى الله عليه وسلم The Messenger of Allah said:
عُرِضَتْ عَلَيَّ الْأُمَمُ بِالْمَوْسِمِ أَيَّامَ الْحَجِّ، فَأَعْجَبَنِي كَثَرَةُ أُمَّتِي، قَدْ مَلَأُوا السَّهْلَ وَالْجَبَلَ، قَالُوا: يَا مُحَمَّدُ، أَرْضَيْتَ؟ قَالَ: نَعَمْ، أَيُّ رَبٍّ، قَالَ: فَإِنْ مَعَ هَؤُلَاءِ سَبْعِينَ أَلْفًا يَدْخُلُونَ الْجَنَّةَ بِغَيْرِ حِسَابٍ، وَهُمْ الَّذِينَ لَا يَسْتَرْقُونَ وَلَا يَكْتُونُونَ، وَلَا وَعَلَى رَبِّهِمْ يَتَوَكَّلُونَ، قَالَ عَكَاشَةُ: يَتَطَيَّرُونَ فَأَدِيعَ اللَّهُ أَنْ يَجْعَلَنِي مِنْهُمْ، قَالَ اللَّهُمَّ اجْعَلْهُ مِنْهُمْ، فَقَالَ رَجُلٌ آخَرُ: ادْعُ اللَّهَ يَجْعَلَنِي مِنْهُمْ، قَالَ: سَبَقَكَ بِهَا عَكَاشَةُ.

The reliance on Allah of the Messenger of Allah صلى الله عليه وسلم was the best. He took all the means according to the situation that he faced. He wore his armour when he went to war. He hid in the cave of Thaur for three days, when he was being pursued by the disbelievers, who wanted to kill him.

Tawakkul is to rely on Allah, while taking the means, believing that the means will only work by you your reliance on Allah. So you must appreciate the means. This is the straight path. In order to make your worship rise high, rely on Allah. Tawakkul is the maximum level of tawheed. Not everyone can do this. Allah guides only some people to it, because He knows who is worthy of this elevated worship.

Tawakkul is one of the main constituents of tawheed. It is a quality of عباد الرحمن, the special slaves of the Most Merciful,

distinguishing them. It is a symbol of belief.

In the hands of Allah are benefit and harm. If Allah doesn't will it, no one can touch you in harm, however much they try. In the same way, no one can benefit you if Allah doesn't wish it for you. This is the virtue of tawakkul.

Tawakkul brings hope. The one who relies on Allah is a free bird, soaring in the sky, not attached to anyone or anything. His heart is at rest.

The one who relies on the means, disables himself, making the means invalid. Another way to negate the tawakkul is to disable the means. He is deceived.
