### Introduction

Verily You are able to do all things. The Most Merciful of the Duniya and Akhira and The Especially Merciful, You give mercy to whomever You will and withhold it from whomever You will. Have mercy on me a mercy that will suffice me from any mercy besides Yours.)

- The one who's in debt is constantly thinking of how they will get money, whether to work more, ask someone to lend them, or other means.
- Shirk takes place when we think someone else can give us dominion. Our problems in life will be solved when there is tawheed Allah, and our problems in life come about when there is shirk, astaghfar Allah. To come out of any problem requires that we return back to Allah (ﷻ) with Tawheed Al Uloohiya.

### Guidance in Surah An Naml



- An advanced civilization constantly needs guidance.

#### Ayah 2:

هُدًىٰ وَبُشْرَىٰ لِلْمُؤْمِنِينَ

**A guide (to the Right Path) and glad tidings for the believers [who believe in the Oneness of Allah (i.e. Islamic Monotheism)].**

- The more we believe, the more there will be guidance. And guidance comes together with glad tidings. Our faith increases when we look at Allah's actions, but our faith decreases when we look at the means and people's actions.

#### Ayah 24:

وَجَدْتُهَا وَقَوْمَهَا يَسْجُدُونَ لِلشَّمْسِ مِنْ دُونِ اللَّهِ وَرَبِّنَ لَهُمُ الشَّيْطَانُ أَعْمَالَهُمْ فَصَدَّهُمْ عَنِ السَّبِيلِ فَهُمْ لَا يَهْتَدُونَ

**"I found her and her people worshipping the sun instead of Allah, and Shaitan (Satan) has made their deeds fair-seeming to them, and has barred them from (Allah's) Way: so they have no guidance."**

- The people of Balqees are not guided because the shaitan beautified shirk to them. The Qur'an brings guidance while the shaitan causes misguidance.

#### Ayah 41:

قَالَ نَكْرُوا لَهَا عَرْشَهَا تَنْظُرُ أَنْهَتِي أَمْ تَكُونُ مِنَ الَّذِينَ لَا يَهْتَدُونَ

**He said: "Disguise her throne for her that we may see whether she will be guided (to recognise her throne), or she will be one of those not guided.**

- Sometimes with misguidance, people cannot recognize what they have.

#### Ayah 63:

أَمْ يَهْدِيْكُمْ فِي ظُلْمَاتِ الْبَرِّ وَالْبَحْرِ وَمَنْ يُرْسِلُ الرِّيَاحَ بُشْرًا بَيْنَ يَدِيْ رَحْمَتِهِ إِلَّهٌ مَعَ اللَّهِ تَعَالَى اللَّهُ عَمَّا يُشْرِكُونَ

**Is not He (better than your gods) Who guides you in the darkness of the land and the sea, and Who sends the winds as heralds of glad tidings, going before His Mercy (rain)? Is**



**there any ilah (god) with Allah? High Exalted be Allah above all that they associate as partners (to Him)!**

- Then comes guidance and glad tidings again. When evil is removed then a person can see clearly.

**Allah Al Hadi (الهادي) – The One Who Guides**

**Surah Al Hajj 54:**

وَلَيَعْلَمَ الَّذِينَ أُتُوا الْعِلْمَ أَنَّهُ الْحَقُّ مِنْ رَبِّكَ فَيُؤْمِنُوا بِهِ فَتَخْبِتَ لَهُ قُلُوبُهُمْ ۝ وَإِنَّ اللَّهَ لَهُادِ الَّذِينَ آمَنُوا إِلَى صِرَاطِ  
مُسْتَقِيمٍ

**And that those who have been given knowledge may know that it (this Qur'an) is the truth from your Lord, so that they may believe therein, and their hearts may submit to it with humility. And verily, Allah is the Guide of those who believe, to the Straight Path.**

- Allah (ﷻ) will bring everything to us. Sometimes we think guidance is when we go to something, but Allah (ﷻ) even guides by bringing things to us.
- Allah Al Hadi directs and guides those who believe in Him and His Messengers to the clear truth.
- Allah Al Hadi guides the creation to know Him and to His Lordship. He will show the people to know He is Ar Rabb, The One taking care of them, giving them and withholding from them.
- Allah Al Hadi guides the slaves to Him and shows them the way to Him through a path of goodness and the deeds which draw them closer to Him.
- Allah Al Hadi is the One Who grants special guidance to whomever He wills. With Allah (ﷻ), do not put your ideas forward, but rememebr "I do not know but You know" – this is tawwakul.
- Allah Al Hadi is the One Who guides the animals to what benefit them and to seek their provision.

**Surah Ta Ha 50:**

قَالَ رَبُّنَا الَّذِي أَعْطَنِي كُلَّ شَيْءٍ خَلْقَهُ ثُمَّ هَدَى



[Musa (Moses)] said: "Our Lord is He Who gave to each thing its form and nature, then guided it aright."

- Allah (ﷻ) gave each creation roles which are suitable for them. When there is a role we cannot do then it is not for us and when we can do a role that is easy for us then this is what we are good at. We cannot say, "how can they do it?". Each person is guided to what they are able to do.
- Allah Al Hadi is the One Who guides to the path of salvation. He guides them to all that benefits them and keeps them away from what harms them.
- Allah Al Hadi teaches the slaves what they do not know and He teaches them how to implement it. He also guides them to taqwa and to cause their hearts to submit to Him.

### Supplications of Guidance (أدعية الهدایة)

Dua: "اللَّهُمَّ رَبَّ جِبْرِيلَ وَمِيكَائِيلَ وَإِسْرَافِيلَ فَاطِرِ السَّمَاوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضِ عَالِمِ الْغَيْبِ وَالشَّهَادَةِ أَنْتَ تَحْكُمُ بَيْنَ عِبَادِكَ" (O Allah, (فِيمَا كَانُوا فِيهِ يَخْتَلِفُونَ اللَّهُمَّ اهْدِنِي لِمَا اخْتَلَفَ فِيهِ مِنَ الْحَقِّ إِنَّكَ تَهْدِي مَنْ تَشَاءُ إِلَى صِرَاطِ مُسْتَقِيمٍ") O Allah, Lord of Jibril, Mika'il and Israfil, Creator of the heavens and the earth, Knower of the unseen and the seen, You judge between Your slaves concerning wherein they differ. O Allah, guide me to the disputed matters of truth for You are the One Who guides to the Straight Path)<sup>1</sup>

- (أَمْنٌ يَهْدِيْكُمْ فِي ظُلْمَاتِ الْبَرِّ وَالْبَحْرِ) (Is not He (better than your gods) Who guides you in the darkness of the land and the sea,): a sign of an advanced civilization is when it provides light when it is dark, and this shows it cares for safety. When we are in a situation of darkness, only Allah (ﷻ) can take us out and grant us light. Allah (ﷻ) guides to knowledge and actions, and when we are guided then there is salvation.

The Messenger of Allah (ﷻ) said: "Indeed Allah has made a parable of the straight path: At the sides of the path there are walls with open doors, each door having a curtain. There is a caller at the head of the path calling, and a caller above it calling. And Allah invites to the abode of peace and guides whomever He wills to the straight path. The doors which are on the sides of the path are the Hudud (legal limitations) of Allah; no one breaches the Hudud of Allah except that curtain is lifted, and the one calling from above it is his Lord."

Avoid falsehood, for falsehood leads to wickedness, and wickedness to hell; and if a man continues to speak falsehood and makes falsehood his object, he will be recorded in Allah's presence as a great liar. And adhere to truth, for truth leads to good deeds, and good deeds lead to paradise. If a man continues to speak the truth and makes truth his object, he will be recorded with Allah as truthful.

"In his Khutbah the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) used to praise Allah as He deserves to be praised, then he would say: 'Whomsoever Allah guides, none can lead him astray, and whomsoever Allah sends astray, none can guide. The truest of word is the Book of Allah and best of guidance is the guidance of Muhammad. The worst of things are those that are newly invented; every newly-invented thing is an innovation and every innovation is going astray, and every going astray is in the Fire.' Then he said: 'The Hour and I have been sent like these two.' Whenever he mentioned the Hour, his cheeks would turn red, and he would raise his voice and become angry, as if he were warning of an approaching army and saying: 'An army is coming to attack you in the morning, or in the evening!' (Then he said): 'Whoever leaves behind wealth, it is for his family, and whoever leaves behind a debt or dependents, then these are my responsibility, and I am the most entitled to take care of the believers.'"

- (وَمَنْ يُنْزِلُ الرِّيَاحَ بُشْرًا) (and Who sends the winds as heralds of glad tidings): Allah (ﷻ) sends the wind as glad tidings. We need to know after guidance there will be glad tidings. Many times we are just looking for bad news, or we ask, "what's happening?" – looking forward to hear bad news. An advanced civilization is not the one to spread bad news but glad tidings. When (الرِّيَاح) (wind) is in the plural form then it is good wind (in the case of this ayah), but (ريح) (wind) in the singular form then this is punishment.

## Winds (رياح) in the Sunnah
