## Surah Al Kahf

Whatever happens, we are protected - our hearts, our minds, and our bodies in our caves, they are lit with our faith.

نَحْنُ نَقُصُّ عَلَيْكَ نَبَأَهُم بِالْحَقِّ إِنَّهُمْ فِتْيَةٌ آمَنُوا بِرَبِّهِمْ وَزِدْنَاَهُمْ هُدًى - 18:13

It is We who relate to you, [O Muhammad], their story in truth. Indeed, they were youths who believed in their Lord, and We increased them in guidance

Allah SWT says that He relates this story to Nabi SAW, a detailed version of the events. Allah SWT is the Most Truthful, so His Narration is not just a telling of events but also the informing of important news/information. These four stories in this surah all offer protection in the times of fitna - in keeping us firm, to help us get through the trial, subhanAllah. During trials, each atom of faith now is worth more. When we go through any trial, it is just a nurturing from Allah SWT.

The story is of young boys, and it is known that young boys who love the religion and who are raised on the deen are amongst those who will be in the shade on the Day of Judgment. So these boys believed in Allah SWT's Lordship and He appreciated their faith and guided them to act and speak in the right way. In times of trials, we need to increase our belief in Allah's Lordship, then He will guide us to what we should do and say. He will increase us and guard us in the times of trials, subhanAllah.

وَرَبَطْنَا عَلَى قُلُوبِهِمْ إِذْ قَامُوا فَقَالُوا رَبُّنَا رَبُّ السَّمَاوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضِ لَنْ نَدْعُو مِنْ دُونِهِ إِلَهًا لَقَدْ قُلْنَا إِذَا شَطَطًا - 18:14

And We made firm their hearts when they stood up and said, "Our Lord is the Lord of the heavens and the earth. Never will we invoke besides Him any deity. We would have certainly spoken, then, an excessive transgression.

Then Allah SWT for these boys tied their hearts to Him, meaning to be patient, firm, and tranquil, just like He tied the heart of Ummi Musa.
