

INTRODUCTION

- In Surah Aal Imraan, it is not about learning new things, but to be firm on what we learned when we go through situations.
- We do not want to give up and turn away. We want to remain determined and never think any situation we go through is to make us weak.
- It is very painful to be guided and then to leave the path of guidance, we ask Allah (سبحانه) (وتعالى) for the well-being. Ameen.

- There are examples of those who started right, taught others and then some trial took place and the person turned away from guidance. After guiding others, they go to misguiding others. We ask Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) for the well-being. Ameen.
- It is important to always go to what is solid and not to something unclear.

SURAH AAL IMRAAN 8

رَبَّنَا لَا تُزِغْ قُلُوبَنَا بَعْدَ إِذْ هَدَيْتَنَا وَهَبْ لَنَا مِنْ لَدُنْكَ رَحْمَةً إِنَّكَ
 أَنْتَ الْوَهَّابُ

[Who say], "Our Lord, let not our hearts deviate after You have guided us and grant us from Yourself mercy. Indeed, You are the Bestower.

LIVE WITH THE QUR'AN –

SURAH AAL IMRAAN

Something that we always need to hold on to is the Qur'an. Most of the time deviation takes place when going into unclear matters. It is important to always go back to Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) and to believe in Him.

SURAH AAL IMRAAN 7

هُوَ الَّذِي أَنْزَلَ عَلَيْكَ الْكِتَابَ مِنْهُ آيَاتٌ مُّحْكَمَاتٌ هُنَّ أُمُّ الْكِتَابِ
 وَأُخْرُ مُتَشَابِهَاتٍ فَمَمَّا الَّذِينَ فِي قُلُوبِهِمْ زَيْغٌ فَيَتَبَعُونَ مَا تَشَابَهَ
 مِنْهُ ابْتِغَاءَ الْفِتْنَةِ وَابْتِغَاءَ تَأْوِيلِهِ وَمَا يَعْلَمُ تَأْوِيلُهُ إِلَّا اللَّهُ
 وَالرَّاسِخُونَ فِي الْعِلْمِ يَقُولُونَ آمَنَّا بِهِ كُلُّ مِنْ عِنْدِ رَبِّنَا وَمَا يَذَّكِرُ
 إِلَّا أُولُو الْأَلْبَابِ

It is He who has sent down to you, [O Muhammad (ﷺ)], the Book; in it are verses [that are] precise - they are the foundation of the Book - and others unspecific. As for those in

whose hearts is deviation [from truth], they will follow that of it which is unspecific, seeking discord and seeking an interpretation [suitable to them]. And no one knows its [true] interpretation except Allah. But those firm in knowledge say, "We believe in it. All [of it] is from our Lord." And no one will be reminded except those of understanding.

BELIEF ABOUT THE QUR'AN

ALL AYAT ARE SOLID AND FIRM

- We need to believe that the all the ayat of the Qur'an, from the start to end are all (مُحْكَم) – they are solid, firm and correct, whether we understand them or not.
- Even if there are ayat that are unclear to us, we still believe they are (مُحْكَم) and solid, but it is our limited mind that cannot understand.

- Deviation takes place when people do not understand something and they start to misinterpret it.
- Every ayah of the Qur'an is perfect, every ayah of the Qur'an is excellent, every ayah of the Qur'an is just.
- The Qur'an is the best, but who will benefit from it? Those who have absolute certainty in the Qur'an.

SURAH AL MAEDA 50

وَمَنْ أَحْسَنْ مِنَ اللَّهِ حُكْمًا لِّقَوْمٍ يُوقِنُونَ

But who is better than Allah in judgement for a people who are certain [in faith].

ALL AYAT RESEMBLE EACH OTHER

- All of the Qur'an is (متشابه), what does that mean?

IN BEAUTY

○ All ayat resemble one another in their beauty. For example, we may be in a garden with different colored flowers, but all of them are beautiful, and no one more beautiful than the other. Everyone is beautiful, regardless of their size, height or color.

SURAH AZ ZUMAR 23

اللَّهُ نَزَّلَ أَحْسَنَ الْحَدِيثِ كِتَابًا مُّتَشَابِهًًا مَّثَانِي

Allah has sent down the best statement: a consistent Book wherein is reiteration.

○ Every ayah of the Qur'an is perfect and beautiful, even if there is an ayah that talks about Firaoun, or the hellfire or the speech of the disbelievers. It is all Kalam Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) – The Word of Allah (سبحانه وتعالى) – and this is what makes it beautiful.

IN ELOQUENCE

- Every ayah of the Qur'an is eloquent, with a beautiful sound and rhythm.

COMPLEMENT AND CONFIRM EACH OTHER

- Every ayah of the Qur'an complements and confirms and supports the another.

CONCLUSION

- In conclusion, all of the ayat of the Qur'an are (محكم) and (متشابه).
- They are (محكم) because they are perfect, excellent, distinct and full of wisdom.
- And they are (متشابه) resembling each other in their beauty, eloquence and meaning.
- We cannot say, "this ayah is better than this ayah" because it is all from Allah (سبحانه وتعالى).
